## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND THE

# NATIONAL COUNCIL OF FIELD LABOR LOCALS, AFGE, AFL-CIO

#### I. Introduction:

This is a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) entered into between the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) and the National Council of Field Labor Locals (NCFLL), AFGE, AFL-CIO, in accordance with the applicable provision of the master DOL-NCFLL Agreement.

#### II. Subject:

This MOU concerns the impact and implementation of the Wage and Hour Division H-1B JRC Form.

## III. Terms of Agreement:

The United States Department of Labor, Wage and Hour Division, shall take the following steps to ensure that NCFLL bargaining unit employees do not experience adverse consequences as a result of using the H-1B JRC Form (whether in hard or electronic formats):

- 1. All affected employees will be provided training on completing the H-1B JRC Form as it relates to the H-1B program. Any H-1B training session will include training on how to use the H-1B JRC Form. Additionally, Wage and Hour will prepare a "FAQ" on how to use the H-1B JRC Form, updated appropriately. The Department will distribute the FAQ through normal channels and to the NCFLL Executive Committee.
- 2. Wage and Hour recognizes that the information needed to complete the H-1B JRC Form can be of unusual complexity and not easily discernible. Wage and Hour agrees to allow a sufficient amount of time to gather, analyze, and record that information. Such time will be reported on the diary sheet with an "action" entry describing the work performed.
- 3. Where appropriate, Wage and Hour will include "Not Applicable" or "Unknown" as possible answers on the H-1B JRC Form.
- 4. The Department (WH National Office) will disseminate a copy of this MOU to all Wage and Hour managers and bargaining unit employees.
- 5. The Department will advise the NCFLL of any changes that affect the H-1B JRC Form.
