NCFLL Per Capita Frequently Asked Questions



How much is NCFLL per capita?

Locals affiliated with the NCFLL pay to the NCFLL \$2.75 per month for each member.

When is NCFLL per capita due?

Per capita is paid in arrears on the last day of the month. For example, per capita for the month of March is due and payable on March 31, per capita for the month of April is due and payable on April 30.

How does a Local know how many members on which to compute NCFLL per capita?

Locals maintain their membership rosters and have access to those rosters on the AFGE Web site. Membership numbers may be taken from the AFGE Web site on the last day of the month.

Or, Locals may wish to wait for their AFGE per capita bill and then write both an AFGE per capita check and an NCFLL per capita check, based on the membership numbers shown on the AFGE per capita bill.

To calculate the NCFLL per capita amount, use the AFGE membership numbers, but DO NOT pay NCFLL per capita on retired members.

Why doesn't the NCFLL bill Locals for per capita?

The NCFLL does not bill affiliated Locals for per capita. The NCFLL does not have access to Locals' membership rosters, making timely and accurate billing impossible.

Why do we have to fill out an additional form to enclose with our per capita payments?

The Monthly Per Capita Statement (copy attached) provides a record for both the Local and the NCFLL as to how the per capita payment(s) should be applied. Please provide all of the information requested on the Monthly Per Capita Statement.

Can NCFLL per capita payments be made electronically?

Not at this time.
